In honor of Breast Cancer Awareness Month, this toolkit provides important information and actionable steps you can take right now. Breast cancer affects **millions of families** each year, and early detection is one of the most effective ways to save lives. With advancements in policy and screening technology, now is the time to take action and ensure every woman has access to the care she deserves.

Background and Current Policies:

- Approximately 1 in 8 women will be diagnosed with breast cancer in their lifetime, affecting thousands of Americans each year.
- Half of women over the age of 40 in the United States have dense breast tissue, which
 can make it harder to detect cancer on mammograms. Dense tissue not only
 complicates screening but also increases the risk of developing breast cancer.
- In September 2024, the <u>FDA</u> issued a national standard requiring all mammography reports to include an assessment of breast density, enhancing early detection by ensuring women are informed of this important risk factor.
- Currently, 39 states and Washington, DC have reporting requirements in place.

The Find It Early Act:

- The Find It Early Act (<u>US HR 3086</u>) would require insurers to cover advanced breast imaging – at no out-of-pocket cost – for women with dense breast tissue following a mammogram.
- This bill addresses insurance coverage gaps, ensuring all women receive consistent access to critical breast imaging services, no matter their state of residence.
